In 1997, Black Mountain Presbyterian Church received a generous bequest that established our Endowment Fund. Since then, our Fund has grown through the generosity of our church family and the stewardship of the Presbyterian Foundation. For the past twenty years our Endowment Fund has made it possible for BMPC to step up and accept new opportunities. Funds have supported a diverse array of projects and activities, always focusing on the key areas designated by Session twenty years ago: Mission and Outreach, Worship and Music, Scholarships for Youth, the Weekday School, and Property.

Black Mountain Presbyterian Church has recently received a very generous gift of \$50,000 to finally establish our Property Fund. The same donors are challenging our congregation to pledge an additional \$50,000 gift in 2018, which the donors will match with an additional gift of \$50,000. This will bring the total of our Property Fund to \$150,000.

Our Church buildings serve our congregation and the broader community every day. They provide space and shelter for the children in our Weekday School. Mission projects like “Rise Against Hunger” have room to grow. Our Church family and neighbors gather in our building to celebrate weddings and baptisms. Under its roof we worship, share fellowship, and nurture those around us.
