Position Summary

The Interim Director of Children's Ministries (Part-Time), with the support of the Christian Education Ministry Team, is responsible for providing educational opportunities to Elementary Aged Children (Kindergarten through 5th grade) designed to increase knowledge and understanding of the Word of God and the life of teaching of Jesus Christ; and to encourage the practice of this knowledge and understanding of our lives as Christians.

Reports To: Pastor/Head of Staff

Responsibilities:

- Coordinating and resourcing Church School programs for K-5, providing chosen curriculum, and the training and support of the teachers/leaders
- Participate in the planning and coordinating of seasonal worship and events (i.e. Family Game
 Night, Advent Carol & Singing, the Children and Family Christmas Service, and others as needed)
- Supporting intergenerational Wednesday evening "Family Around the Table" gatherings
- Plan, coordinate and lead "Time with Children" during Eleven O'clock worship service
- Maintain inventory of supplies needed for regular and special programming according to budget and program priorities
- Staying aware of the activities of BMPC by attending Christian Education Ministry Team meetings, staff meetings, and as needed session meetings
- Provide a warm and welcoming environment for children of all ages
- Develop strong one-on-one relationships with children and their families, so as to nurture and mentor them in Christian faith.
- Adhere to BMPC Child Protection Policy and maintain accurate records with regards to children's ministry
- Understand and actively support the theological identity of BMPC as articulated in our current Mission Study
